Reporting to VP Exploration and Geoscience, the selected individual will be accountable to provide integrated geologic interpretations, and plan and execute delineation and horizontal SAGD well campaigns that will support current and future Heavy Oil projects in Saskatchewan. The ideal candidate will be adaptable, collaborative and outcome focused with a positive attitude. This a full-time, contract position, based in the Calgary office and includes periodic on-call responsibilities outside of normal office hours.

Key Accountabilities

- Well planning, licensing, and delivery/execution: project management, subsurface inputs and risk identification/mitigation, horizontal well landing and geo-steering.
- On-call responsibilities working directly with wellsite geologists and drilling engineers to deliver lateral trajectories that maximize resource recovery.
- Integrate various suites of geological data including core, logs, and petrophysical data to understand the pad area and optimize lateral trajectories through geo-steering
- Support efforts to appraise and delineate potential resource for future thermal development
- Supporting project delivery, compiling pre-drill and updating post-drill data; preparing documentation and presentations for technical reviews, lookbacks, and knowledge shares
- Support near-field exploration and delineation through mapping and detailed geological evaluation, value capture, and risk mitigation.
- Provide geological support to M&A activities.
